STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of Completion of the Library, Science and Classroom Building at Gorham State Teachers College.

Library, Science and Classroom Building; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund the sum of \$1,315,348 in favor of Gorham State Teachers College for the completion of the Library, Science and Classroom building at Gorham State Teachers College, and be it further

Resolved: That this appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been completed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Gorham State Teachers College is extremely overcrowded, and the completion of the Library, Science and Classroom building will provide for present enrollment and future expansion, directly resulting in the provision of more teachers for the State of Maine. The 97th Legislature appropriated \$434,000 to initiate this building. It is planned to complete this unit by providing classroom area in addition to the Science wing totaling 34,383 square feet with a library area totaling 23,395 square feet to house 91,000 volumes.
