STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Towns of Smithfield and Mercer.

Towns of Smithfield and Mercer; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund the sum of \$750 to be paid to the town of Smithfield, and \$750 to be paid to the town of Mercer for damage done to a culvert.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The culvert was built in 1953 at North pond on the boundary line between the towns of Smithfield and Mercer. In 1954, Fish and Game wardens in destroying a beaver dam also destroyed the culvert. This resolve is to obtain money to replace the culvert.
