**RESOLVE, to Reimburse Old Town School Department for Tuition for
Children Living on Indian Island.**

Old Town School Department; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the State the sum of \$1,153.38 to be paid to the School Department of Old Town to pay said town for the tuition of seven children for the school year 1956-1957.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The seven children for whom reimbursement is claimed live on Indian Island and attend the elementary and secondary schools in Old Town. The children are less than quarter-blood Indians and not members of the Penobscot Tribe of Indians, therefore their tuition cannot be paid out of Indian funds.
