STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Establishing Poetry Day in Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 11, § 12-A, additional. Chapter 11 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding a new section to be numbered 12-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 12-A. Poetry Day. The Governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart October 15th as Poetry Day, recommending that in the week following the proclamation schools, churches, libraries, clubs and organizations, the newspapers, radio and television give recognition to the poets who have helped to make Maine famous in the field of poetry throughout the world.'
