AN ACT Relating to Rabbit Hunting in Washington County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 106, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 106 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘There shall be a closed season on wild hares or rabbits from the 1st day of March to the 30th day of the following September, both days inclusive, except in the counties of Franklin, Oxford, Knox, Somerset, Penobscot, Piscataquis, Aroostook, **Washington** and York, where there shall be a closed season from the 1st day of April to the 30th day of the following September, both days inclusive.’
