

STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Free Fishing Licenses to Residents Seventy-Five Years of Age.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 39, sub-§ XII-A, additional. Section 39 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subsection to be numbered XII-A, to read as follows:

'XII-A. A license to fish shall be issued, if applied for, free of charge, to every resident of the State who has reached the age of 75 years.'
