IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Weymouth Pond and Mower Pond, Penobscot County.

Fishing in Weymouth pond and Mower pond; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to open Weymouth pond in St. Albans and Corinna, and Mower pond in Corinna, Penobscot county to fishing under the general law.
