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## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 98th LEGISLATURE

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 359, L.D. 489, Resolve, Closing Waters Near Grand Lake Stream Dam to Fishing.

Amend said Resolve by inserting after the Title and before the headnote the following Emergency Preamble:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves passed by the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies: and

Whereas it is, immediately necessary to close the waters near Grand Lake Stream dam to fishing; and

Whereas, such legislation is in the best interest of conserving our natural resources; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine, and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it!

Further amend said Resolve by adding at the end thereof the following Emergency Clause:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.'
