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**AN ACT Relating to the Visible Indication of Elapsed Time on Parking Meters.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 91, § 87, amended.** Section 87 of chapter 91 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the 1st paragraph thereof, a new paragraph, as follows:

‘Each parking meter already installed or which may be installed hereafter under the provisions of this section or any similar device, instrument or other apparatus used for indicating, measuring, calculating or registering the passage or quantity of elapsed time for which a charge is made for parking, shall contain a calibrated scale, expressed in time increments of minutes, upon which the time elapsed after the deposit of the user’s coin shall be accurately registered by a movement hand or other suitable indicator. Such scale and indicator shall be plainly visible at all times to the user of said meter.’
