IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Discontinued Schoolhouse Lots.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 41, § 15, amended. Section 15 of chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the 1st sentence thereof, a new sentence, as follows:

'When such property has been in use as a schoolhouse lot for a period of not less than 40 years, upon discontinuance of the schoolhouse use, said property shall not revert to the owner, his heirs or assigns, but shall be the property of the municipality in which it is located at the time of such discontinuance.'
