RESOLVE, Authorizing Board of Bar Examiners to Permit Albert N. Tardif of Portland, to Take Bar Examination.

Resolved: That the Board of Examiners for the examination of applicants for admission to the Bar be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to permit Albert N. Tardif of Portland, to take the examination for admission to the Bar notwithstanding the provisions of sections one to 9, inclusive, of chapter 105 of the Revised Statutes.
