STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Holding Property by Home for Aged Men in Bangor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1893, c. 557, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 557 of the private and special laws of 1893, as amended by chapter 251 of the private and special laws of 1905 and by chapter 13 of the private and special laws of 1929, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 2. Amount increased. Under the above name, said corporation may sue and be sued, take by purchase, devise or otherwise, real and personal property and hold the same for the purposes expressed in section one, to an any amount not exceeding five hundred thousand dollars, and manage and dispose of the same for the purposes aforesaid; and shall possess all the rights, privileges and immunities, which belong to corporations created for charitable objects, under the laws of this state.'

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
