CONFERENCE COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 381, L. D. 510, Bill, "An Act Relating to Sale of Certain Beverages to Minors."

Amend said Bill by striking out the Title and inserting in place thereof the following title: 'An Act Defining Liquor under Liquor Laws.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"R. S., c. 61, §1, amended. The 12th paragraph of section 1 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

' "Liquor" shall mean and include any alcoholic, spirituous, vinous, fermented or other alcoholic beverage, or combination of liquors and mixed liquors, intended for human consumption, which contains more than ~~1%~~ 1/2 of ~~1%~~ of alcohol by volume.' "
