

STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Increasing Salary of Recorder of Eastport Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1915, c. 34, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 34 of the private and special laws of 1915, as last amended by section 2 of chapter 90 of the private and special laws of 1955, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 2. Salary of recorder, when paid; fees. The recorder of the Eastport municipal court shall receive as compensation an annual salary of \$250 \$400, payable quarterly, from the county treasury of the county of Washington, on the first days of January, April, July and October. All fees collected by him shall be paid over to the county treasurer.'
