RESOLVE, in Favor of Mabelle K. Toole of Bangor.

Mabelle K. Toole; to be given credit. Resolved: That Mabelle K. Toole of Bangor, be given credit for 6 years of teaching service, and that she may be entitled to an additional retirement benefit under the provisions of chapter 63-A of the Revised Statutes.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In 1949 the Legislature gave Mrs. Toole credit for 6 years of teaching in St. John's grammar school in Bangor. She had taught there 12 years and is seeking credit for the additional 6 years of service.
