**RESOLVE, Providing for an Increase in State Pension for Ina J. Alto
of Jefferson.**

Ina J. Alto; state pension increased. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Ina (Eina) J. Alto, of Jefferson, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin July 1, 1957, and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

That part of chapter 194 of the resolves of 1949 which provides for a state pension for Ina (Eina) Alto, of Jefferson, is hereby repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Alto, age 79, an alien, occupies a small home in Jefferson together with her niece, Mrs. Hirvilla, her husband, and their five year old daughter. The niece works at Lipman Poultry Company and the husband does odd jobs of common labor. Mrs. Alto uses the \$30 per month, that she is now receiving, for her share of food and most of her clothing are given to her by her friends.
