IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Licensing for Interstate Transportation of Lobsters.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, §113, amended. The 3rd paragraph of section 113 of chapter 38 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The fee for such license shall be \$50 with an extra fee of \$5 for each additional boat, truck, automobile, airplane or other means of transportation to be used; provided that such additional boat, truck, automobile, airplane or other vehicle used in such transportation shall be the property of said licensee; provided further that any person licensed as a wholesale sea food dealer and processor under the provisions of section III may procure this license upon payment of \$25.'
