#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

#### AN ACT Providing for Clerk Hire for Fort Fairfield Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1947, c. 163, § 1, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 1 of chapter 163 of the private and special laws of 1947, as amended by chapter 65 of the private and special laws of 1953, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The judge shall reside at Fort Fairfield. He shall be appointed and give bond in accordance with the Constitution and laws of this State. His salary shall be \$2,900 a year, to be paid monthly from the treasurer of the county of Aroostook, and \$1,000 annually additional for clerk hire.'
