HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 403, L. D. 533, Bill, "An Act to Revise  
Certain Motor Vehicle Laws."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of "Sec. 6" and inserting  
in place thereof the following:

"Sec. 6. R. S., c. 22, §89, amended. The last paragraph of  
section 89 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is hereby repealed  
and the following paragraph enacted in place thereof:

'Any person who operates a vehicle past a "yield right of way"  
sign, and collides with a vehicle or pedestrian proceeding on the  
intersecting street shall upon conviction be guilty of a misdemeanor.'
