AN ACT Relating to Certain Municipalities Maintaining Paupers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 94, § 25, amended. Section 25 of chapter 94 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 87 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 25. Certain larger municipalities to maintain their paupers. ~~Plantations~~ Municipalities having a population of 200 or more and a valuation of at least \$250,000 shall support the paupers therein, in the same manner that towns now do, and the expenses therefor shall not be chargeable to the State.'
