STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of Francis J. Arnold of Providence, Rhode Island.

Francis J. Arnold; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the State the sum of \$608.17 to be paid to Francis J. Arnold, of Providence, Rhode Island, as full and final settlement of his claim against the State, for damage done to his automobile by escapee of State School for Boys.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In October of 1955 an escapee of the State School for Boys stole an automobile. While an officer was pursuing the escapee, the escapee ran into the car of Mr. Arnold and damaged it. Mr. Arnold had no insurance.
