IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Regulating Taking of Smelts in Certain Waters.

Resolves, 1955, c. 104, amended. Resolved: That the last sentence of the 5th paragraph of that part designated "Androscoggin County" of chapter 104 of the Resolves of 1955 be, and hereby is, amended to read as follows:

'Lake and tributaries closed to the dipping taking of smelts.'; and be it further

Resolved: That the 6th, 7th, 9th and 11th paragraphs of that part designated "Cumberland County" of chapter 104 of the Resolves of 1955 be, and hereby are, amended to read as follows:

'Gay Brook, Raymond. From main highway to Little Rattlesnake Pond, closed to the dipping taking of smelts.

Miller Brook, Bridgton. Closed to the dipping taking of smelts.

Peabody Pond and Tributaries, Naples, Sebago, Bridgton. Closed to the dipping taking of smelts.

Sabbathday Lake, New Gloucester. Tributaries closed to smelt dipping taking of smelts. Daily limit 5 trout or salmon. Use or possession of live fish as bait prohibited.'; and be it further

Resolved: That the 11th and 15th paragraphs of that part designated "Kennebec County" of chapter 104 of the Resolves of 1955 be, and hereby are, amended to read as follows:

'Echo Lake tributaries. Closed to the dipping taking of smelts.

Minnehonk Lake tributaries. Closed to the dipping taking of smelts.'; and be it further

Resolved: That the 7th and 11th paragraphs of that part designated "Oxford County" of chapter 104 of the Resolves of 1955 be, and hereby are, amended to read as follows:

'Bartlett Brook, Stoneham. Closed to the dipping taking of smelts.

Colcord Pond and Tributaries, Porter. Closed to the dipping taking of smelts.'
