IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing for White Perch in Certain Counties.

Fishing for white perch in certain counties; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to remove all bag limits on white perch in the counties of Franklin, Kennebec, Piscataquis and Somerset, and in Mattawamkeag Lake, T.4, R.3 and in Island Falls, Aroostook county; the open season to conform with the general ice fishing and open water fishing seasons in all waters.
