STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Increasing Pensions of Retired Members of the Lewiston Police Department.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XI, § 25-B, additional. Article XI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new section, to be numbered 25-B, to read as follows:

'Sec. 25-B. Increase in pension. Members of the Lewiston police department retiring after April 1, 1957 shall receive, in addition to their retirement pay, such additional amounts as will make their retirement pay equal to $\frac{1}{2}$ of the pay per year that is currently paid to an active member of the Lewiston police department holding the same rank as the retired member held at the time of his retirement. Such increases shall become effective at the same time as the pay of the active members is increased. The provisions of this section shall not apply to members of the Lewiston Police Department under the Maine State Retirement System.'
