## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Uniforms for Members of the Police Department of the City of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XI, § 7-A, amended. Section 7-A of Article XI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as enacted by chapter 191 of the private and special laws of 1951 and amended by chapter 67 of the private and special laws of 1953, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
- **'Sec. 7-A. Uniforms for members.** The city shall supply male members of the police department with necessary uniforms, but shall not expend more than \$100 per member annually. The city shall supply male members of the police department who do not wear uniforms a clothing allowance not to exceed \$100 annually. The provisions of this section shall apply only to those who have been appointed permanent members of the police department for at least 3 years one year.'
