STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Setting Compensation for Members of Lewiston Police Department.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XI, § 1, amended. The last sentence of the 1st paragraph of section 1 of Article XI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 95 of the private and special laws of 1947, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The commission may employ such other employees of the department as it shall deem necessary, prescribe their duties, set their compensation subject to the approval of the board of finance and terminate their employment at pleasure.'

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. VIII, § 4, amended. Section 4 of Article VIII of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 4. General supervision over finances. The board of finance shall have general supervision and full control over the several departments of the city so far as it relates to their financial transactions, records, and auditing and to the receiving and disbursement of monies. The provisions of this section shall not apply to approval of compensation of the police department as prescribed by thepolice commission for its employees.'
