#### **AN ACT Relating to Pensions for Widows and Children of Deceased Policemen of the City of Lewiston.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. § S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XI, § 21, amended.** The 2nd paragraph of section 21 of Article XI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as enacted by chapter 202 of the private and special laws of 1955, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'If a member of the Lewiston police department should die, **whether he is retired or on active duty, or** as a result of injury received in the line of duty, his widow, or, if none, his minor child or children, shall receive a pension equal to  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the pay of such member at the time of his death. Such pension shall be paid to the widow until she dies or remarries, or to ~~a~~ **his** child or children until they die **or the youngest reach reaches** the age of 18 years.'
