STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Pensions for Widows and Children of Deceased Policemen of the City of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. § S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XI, § 21, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 21 of Article XI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as enacted by chapter 202 of the private and special laws of 1955, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'If a member of the Lewiston police department should die, whether he is retired or on active duty, or as a result of injury received in the line of duty, his widow, or, if none, his minor child or children, shall receive a pension equal to $\frac{1}{2}$ of the pay of such member at the time of his death. Such pension shall be paid to the widow until she dies or remarries, or to **a** his child or children until they die or the youngest reacher the age of 18 years.'
