AN ACT to Exempt Transportation of Christmas Trees from Public Utilities Commission Regulation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 48, § 29, sub-§ I, ¶ J, additional. Subsection I of section 29 of chapter 48 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 331 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new paragraph to be lettered J, to read as follows:

'J. While engaged exclusively in the transportation of Christmas trees, wreaths and greens.'
