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#### **RESOLVE, in Favor of Arthur Payson, of Brooks.**

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**Arthur Payson; pension increased. Resolved:** That the pension of Arthur Payson, of Brooks, be increased from the funds of the Maine State Retirement System to comply with the provisions of chapter 63-A of the Revised Statutes of 1954.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Payson retired on December 11, 1950 on a benefit of \$20.04 which amounted to what in effect was half pay at that time. Mr. Payson had something over 25 years of total service credits toward retirement at the time he originally retired and he is presently 80 years of age. In his best 5 years of earnings Mr. Payson had better compensation than in his last 5 years. This resolve is to correct the inequity.
