RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for Vertine E. Ellis, St. Albans.

Vertine E. Ellis; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Vertine E. Ellis, of St. Albans, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin July 1, 1957 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Vertine E. Ellis is 82 years of age. She taught school for 18 years. She is unable to work and has no family to support her. She has no income.
