AN ACT Suspending Sardine Tax on Certain Cases of Sardines.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 16, § 262, amended. Section 262 of chapter 16 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph, as follows:

'The tax provided by this section shall be suspended on all cases of sardines described in subsection III of section 261 packed between January 1, 1957 and January 1, 1959.'
