RESOLVE, in Favor of Martin Brothers of Van Buren.

Martin Brothers; reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$42 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to Martin Brothers of Van Buren to reimburse them for coal delivered to Louis Chasse, a State Ward; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the State.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

During the months of January and February 1955, the Martin Brothers of Van Buren furnished two tons of coal to Louis Chasse, a state ward. Due to an oversight of the town clerk, the purchase orders for the coal did not specifically state that the coal was for a state ward. The delivery of this coal had been approved and authorized for the years 1954 and 1955 but the bill was submitted too late for payment.
