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**RESOLVE, In Favor of Town of Milo for Aid to Mabelle Brawn.**

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**Town of Milo; reimbursed. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the State the sum of \$55 to be paid to the town of Milo to reimburse it for aid given to Mabelle Brawn.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Brawn, a recipient of Old Age Assistance in the amount of \$55 monthly, and Social Security in the amount of \$31.20 monthly, was a legal resident of Milo.

Mrs. Brawn was confined to her bed in a Convalescent Home from December 25, 1954 until she died on July 26, 1956. As is customary in such cases, the town of Milo pays the expenses and requires the patient to endorse his or her O.A.A. and S.S. checks and have them delivered to the treasurer of the town of Milo. In this case one check in the amount of \$55 was not received.
