STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE in Favor of Maynard Lindsey of Harrington.

Maynard Lindsay; compensated. Resolved. That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund of the State the sum of \$10,000 to be paid to Maynard Lindsey, of Harrington, for injuries sustained in line of duty as a State Police officer.

Statement of Facts.

In January 1947, Maynard Lindsey in attempting to arrest a person who had gone beserk, in the town of Columbia, was shot in his arm, with the bullet lodged in his side. The use of his left arm was greatly impaired. He should be compensated for this injury.
