STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Authorizing Sunset Real Estate Corporation to Construct a Bridge Across Medomak River.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, considerable time is needed to construct the proposed bridge across Medomak River; and

Whereas, winter conditions are unfavorable to building such a structure; and Whereas, a partly constructed bridge might be deteriorated by tide and ice during winter months; and

Whereas, time is the essence in commencing said bridge as the island which said bridge will serve will be developed for summer cottages; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Construction of bridge across Medomak River authorized. Sunset Real Estate Corporation, its successors and assigns, are hereby authorized and empowered to locate, erect and maintain a bridge or roadway across the tidewaters of Medomak River between Wolsgrover Island in the Town of Friendship and the mainland of said Town which lies opposite said Island in an easterly direction therefrom and to adjoin the northwesterly end of the road leading from State Route #220 in said Town of Friendship to Timber Point, so called, in said Town.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.
