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#### **AN ACT Relating to Obstructions in Windows of Liquor Licensed Premises.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 61, § 54-A, additional.** Chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding a new section thereto, to be numbered 54-A, to read as follows:

**'Sec. 54-A. Obstructions in windows. No licensee shall place any material in the windows of his licensed premises which will in any way obstruct a clear view of the premises from the street in front of the licensed premises. The license of any person violating the provisions of this section shall be suspended until such obstruction has been removed.'**
