**RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for Josephine DeLaitte of Verona.**

---

**Josephine DeLaitte; state pension. Resolved:** That a pension of \$40 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Josephine DeLaitte, of Verona, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1957 and continue until June 1, 1958.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Josephine DeLaitte is 50 years of age. She is unable to work and contribute toward her own support. At present she receives \$64 monthly from aid to dependent children for the support of her minor child. Her support has become a burden to the town.
