STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for Josephine DeLaite of Verona.

Josephine DeLaite; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$40 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Josephine DeLaite, of Verona, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1957 and continue until June 1, 1958.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Josephine DeLaite is 50 years of age. She is unable to work and contribute toward her own support. At present she receives \$64 monthly from aid to dependent children for the support of her minor child. Her support has become a burden to the town.
