#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Gertrude Craig of Mount Vernon.

Gertrude Craig; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$25 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Gertrude Craig, of Mount Vernon, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin July 1, 1957, and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Miss Craig is crippled with neuritis and is at present in the Crabtree Rest Home in Mount Vernon, Maine. She has no relatives to help her. She receives Old Age Assistance and \$20 per month from the town of Glenburn where she has a settlement. It takes all of this to pay for her care at the Rest Home and leaves her nothing for medicine or clothing. She formerly received a Disability Pension of \$25 per month and now asks that this pension be reinstated.
