IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for Mrs. Arthur Preston of Rockland.

Mrs. Arthur Preston; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Mrs. Arthur Preston, of Rockland, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1957 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Preston has arthritis. She needs to take medicine which cost her about \$14 per month. Her children are unable to help her. She has a single son who is barely able to support himself as he has a mental condition since returning from Korea.
