**RESOLVE, Regulating the Taking of Clams in Steuben.**

---

**Taking of clams in Steuben, regulated. Resolved:** That the Commissioner of Sea and Shore Fisheries be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue the following rule and regulation:

That it shall be unlawful for any person not a resident of the town of Steuben, in the county of Washington, to dig clams for commercial purposes within the limits of said town;

That persons not residents of the town of Steuben may be permitted to dig for clams for fish bait or home consumption within the limits of said town, provided no person shall dig for such purposes during any one day more than one peck of clams;

That whoever violates the provisions of this rule and regulation shall for each offense be punished by a fine of not more than \$25 or by imprisonment for not more than 30 days.
