### **AN ACT to Provide an Allowance to Retailers for Collecting Sales and Use Tax.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 17, § 15, amended.** The 1st paragraph of section 15 of chapter 17 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new sentence, as follows:

**'Each retailer who remits any tax imposed by this chapter on or before the day when the same shall be required to be paid, may deduct and retain from his remittance as compensation for the collection 3% of the first \$100 of such tax, 2% of such tax over \$100 and under \$300, and 1% of such tax \$300 and over.'**
