STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Increase the Salary of the Judge of the Calais Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1883, c. 325, § 23, amended. The 4th sentence of section 23 of chapter 325 of the private and special laws of 1883, as last amended by section 1 of chapter 58 of the private and special laws of 1955, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The compensation of the judge in full for all services shall be $\frac{2,100}{2,100}$ per year, payable quarterly from the treasury of the county of Washington.'

Sec. 2. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1957.
