SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 454, L. D. 629, Bill, "An Act Repealing Law Prohibiting Riding with a Naked Scythe."

Amend said Bill by striking out the Title and inserting in place thereof the following Title: 'An Act Relating to Concealment of Naked Scythes.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"R. S., c. 137, §28, repealed and replaced. Section 28 of chapter 137 of the Revised Statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 28. Concealment of naked scythe while traveling. Whoever knowingly traverses any highway, lane, street or alley wearing under his clothes or concealed about his person a naked scythe, sharpended and hung in a snath, forfeits \$5 for each offense.'"
