STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Repealing Law Prohibiting Riding with a Naked Scythe.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 137, § 28, repealed. Section 28 of chapter 137 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed as follows:

'See. 28. Riding with a naked seythe. Whoever rides on the highways or in any lanes, streets or alleys with a naked seythe, sharpened and hung in a snath, forfeits \$2 for each offense.'
