STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Prohibiting Motor Vehicles With Excessive Horsepower on Maine Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 38-A, additional. Chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 38-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 38-A. Use of excessive horsepower prohibited. It shall be unlawful to operate on any highway any passenger motor vehicle, except busses with seating capacity of 12 or more, which is registered in the State and which shall have been manufactured or assembled after December 31, 1957, if such vehicle is powered by a motor in excess of 350 advertised brake horsepower.'
