#### AN ACT Relating to Geological Survey Publications.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 38-A, §§ 6-C—6-D, additional.** Chapter 38-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 471 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby amended by adding thereto, 2 new sections to be numbered 6-C and 6-D, to read as follows:

**'Sec. 6-C. Geological Survey Publication Fund, established.** There is hereby established within the Division of Geological Survey a revolving fund for the use of the Division to cover printing and distribution costs for geological and related technical literature.

**Sec. 6-D. Printing and sale of publications.** The Commissioner of Development of Industry and Commerce is authorized to fix the price at which publications of the Maine Geological Survey may be sold and delivered. The Department shall receive without charge 10% of all such publications for complimentary distribution.

The Commissioner is authorized to fix the price at which United States Geological Survey and other United States Government maps, charts and other publications may be sold and delivered, provided such publications are specifically authorized for resale by the originating agency and are specifically concerned with technical information on the State of Maine.'
