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### **AN ACT** Relating to Examinations for Certain Persons to Practice Barbering.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 25, § 219-A, additional.** Chapter 25 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 219-A, to read as follows:

**'Sec. 219-A. Examination for certain barbers. Any person, who has a certificate to practice barbering and who fails to practice barbering for 6 months out of any 3-year period, must obtain a new certificate. He shall be examined by the Board, by practical and modified written examination, on changes in sanitation requirements for barbers and barber shops.'**
