RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for Eva A. Scammon, of Franklin.

Eva A. Scammon; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Eva A. Scammon, of Franklin, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Said pension shall begin on July 1, 1957, and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Scammon is the widow of former superintendent of schools, Sherman S. Scammon. She is 78 years old and has an income of less than \$900 per year which is not sufficient for her needs.
